

## STREET BUSINESS SCHOOL IMPACT STUDY: LEAVING POVERTY BEHIND

Street Business School (SBS) is an award-winning non-profit, providing one-of-a-kind entrepreneurial training for women, proven to significantly increase incomes and lift families out of poverty with dignity. SBS is on a mission to equip 1 million women with business training, helping them to transform their lives and lift themselves and 5 million children out of poverty.

To determine the impact Street Business School has on women living in poverty, researchers from J-PAL at MIT and Universidad del Rosario conducted a randomized control trial, the gold standard for measuring program impact, comparing the outcomes of women who received SBS training with those in a control group who did not.

## MEASURED 12-18 MONTHS AFTER THE TRAINING
